Philadelphia Attorney Rhonda Hill Wilson Appointed to Philadelphia Regional Port Authority Board

Rhonda Hill Wilson, Philadelphia personal injury and nursing home negligence attorney, was recently appointed to serve on the governing board of the **Philadelphia Regional Port Authority (PRPA)**. The 11-member board of regional business leaders is appointed by the Governor, the state legislature, the Mayor of Philadelphia, and the large counties surrounding the Port.

An independent agency of Pennsylvania, PRPA **focuses on the enhancement of water-borne trade and commerce**. In addition to serving on the PRPA board, Hill Wilson was recently **named one of Main Line Today's Women** on Move for her local business success and philanthropic efforts. She serves as a role-model and gives back to her community. Hill Wilson teaches young, inner-city women life skills and goal setting strategies and chairs the United Negro College Fund Philadelphia-area "A Mind Is" Annual Giving Society. From 2003 through March of 2007, Hill Wilson hosted "Truth Rising" which was heard on WURD 900-AM where she discussed local, national and international legal and political issues. In March 2007, Hill Wilson became the co-host of "The Morning Team" on WURD and now substitutes as co-host when needed.
